AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 134

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after “manner;” insert “providing that a violation of this Act is not considered a moving violation for certain purposes;”; in line 6, strike “establishing certain penalties for violations” and substitute “establishing that certain penalties apply to a violation”; and after line 12, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
Article – Transportation
Section 27-101(b)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “**FOR**” in line 7 down through “**OFFENSE**” in line 11 and substitute “**A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS NOT CONSIDERED A MOVING VIOLATION FOR PURPOSES OF § 16-402 OF THIS ARTICLE**”

27-101.

(b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is subject to a fine of not more than \$500.”.
