AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after "manner;" insert "<u>providing that a violation of this Act</u> <u>is not considered a moving violation for certain purposes</u>;"; in line 6, strike "establishing certain penalties for violations" and substitute "<u>establishing that certain</u> <u>penalties apply to a violation</u>"; and after line 12, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

<u>Article – Transportation</u> <u>Section 27-101(b)</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "FOR" in line 7 down through "OFFENSE" in line 11 and substitute "<u>A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS NOT CONSIDERED A</u> <u>MOVING VIOLATION FOR PURPOSES OF § 16-402 OF THIS ARTICLE</u>

<u>27–101.</u>

(b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is subject to a fine of not more than \$500.".
