AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Weldon" and substitute "<u>Weldon</u>, <u>Hammen</u>, <u>Pendergrass</u>, <u>Beitzel</u>, <u>Benson</u>, <u>Costa</u>, <u>Donoghue</u>, <u>Elliott</u>, <u>Hubbard</u>, <u>Kach</u>, <u>Kipke</u>, <u>Kullen</u>, <u>McDonough</u>, <u>Mizeur</u>, <u>Montgomery</u>, <u>Nathan-Pulliam</u>, <u>Oaks</u>, <u>Pena-Melnyk</u>, <u>Reznik</u>, <u>Riley</u>, <u>Tarrant</u>, <u>and V. Turner</u>"; strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute "<u>Procurement – eMaryland Marketplace – Use</u>"; and in line 6, after "Act;" insert "<u>prohibiting an unintentional violation from constituting grounds to challenge or appeal the award of a procurement or the process through which a procurement was conducted;".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 18, after "(8)" insert "EXCEPT FOR THE MARYLAND HEALTH AND HIGHER EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY,"; and after line 23, insert:

- "(C) AN UNINTENTIONAL VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT CONSTITUTE GROUNDS TO CHALLENGE OR APPEAL:
 - (1) THE AWARD OF A PROCUREMENT; OR
- (2) THE PROCESS THROUGH WHICH A PROCUREMENT WAS CONDUCTED.".
