AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1176

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after "Pena-Melnyk," insert "Nathan-Pulliam,"; in the sponsor line, strike "and Waldstreicher" and substitute "Waldstreicher, Hammen, Pendergrass, Beitzel, Benson, Bromwell, Costa, Donoghue, Elliott, Hubbard, Kach, Kipke, Kullen, Montgomery, Morhaim, Riley, and Weldon"; in lines 2, 3, 6, and 8, in each instance, strike "Task Force" and substitute "Committee"; in line 4, strike "advice and"; in line 5, strike "terms,"; in line 11, strike "19-710.4" and substitute "13-2A-01 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 2A. Committee on Childhood Obesity"".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 16, insert:

"SUBTITLE 2A. COMMITTEE ON CHILDHOOD OBESITY.";

in line 17, strike "19-710.4" and substitute "13-2A-01"; and after line 17, insert:

"(A) THERE IS A COMMITTEE ON CHILDHOOD OBESITY IN THE DEPARTMENT.

(B) THE COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF:

(1) THE MEMBERS OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HEART DISEASE AND STROKE; AND

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- (2) THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS WITH EXPERTISE IN OBESITY PREVENTION AND TREATMENT, APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY:
- (I) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF PEDIATRICS;
- (II) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CHILDREN'S NATIONAL MEDICAL CENTER;
- (III) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE JOHNS HOPKINS CHILDREN'S CENTER; AND
- (IV) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF BOARDS OF EDUCATION.
- (C) (1) IN PERFORMING ITS DUTIES, THE COMMITTEE MAY CONSULT WITH INDIVIDUALS AND ENTITIES THAT THE SECRETARY DEEMS APPROPRIATE.
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE COMMITTEE.
- (3) THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL SELECT THE CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS.
- (D) A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE, BUT IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

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- (E) THE COMMITTEE SHALL STUDY CHILDHOOD OBESITY AND, SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE FOLLOWING:
- (1) INSURANCE REIMBURSEMENTS PAID TO HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO DIAGNOSE AND TREAT CHILDHOOD OBESITY;
- (2) A SYSTEM FOR COLLECTING, ANALYZING, AND MAINTAINING STATEWIDE DATA RELATING TO CHILDHOOD OBESITY;
- (3) BEST AND PROMISING PRACTICES TO ADDRESS CHILDHOOD OBESITY, INCLUDING COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL-BASED APPROACHES;
- (4) METHODS TO ENHANCE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE CHRONIC DISEASES RELATED TO CHILDHOOD OBESITY, INCLUDING THE INCREASED NUMBER OF CHILDREN DEVELOPING DIABETES; AND
- (5) <u>METHODS TO INCREASE THE RATE OF BODY MASS INDEX</u> SCREENINGS FOR CHILDREN.
- (F) THE COMMITTEE SHALL REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2009."

On pages 1 through 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 18 on page 1 through line 29 on page 4, inclusive.
