AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 767

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 22, after “terms;” insert “requiring the Board of Pharmacy to monitor the experience of remote automated medication systems in nursing homes in the State and to report to specified legislative committees on the effect of remote automated medication systems on patient safety in nursing homes;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 6, in line 16, strike “AN EMERGENCY” and substitute “A POWER OUTAGE”; after line 22, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Board of Pharmacy shall monitor the experience of remote automated medication systems in nursing homes in the State and shall report on or before January 1, 2009 and on or before January 1, 2010, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee on the effect of remote automated medication systems on patient safety in nursing homes.”;

and in line 23, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
