AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 649, AS AMENDED  
(First Reading File Bill)

On page 1 of the bill, in line 26, strike “a certain term” and substitute “certain terms”.

On page 2 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0649/764031/1), in line 5 of Amendment No. 2, after “(E)” insert “(1)”; in lines 8 and 9, strike “(1)” and “(2)”, respectively, and substitute “(I)” and “(II)”, respectively; and after line 10, insert:

**“(2) “MIXED MARTIAL ARTS” DOES NOT INCLUDE A CONTEST KNOWN AS “ULTIMATE FIGHTING” IN WHICH:**

**(I) ANY PART OF THE BODY OF A CONTESTANT MAY BE USED AS A WEAPON; AND**

**(II) ANY MEANS OF FIGHTING MAY BE USED WITH THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE TO INTENTIONALLY INJURE ANOTHER CONTESTANT IN SUCH A MANNER THAT THE OTHER CONTESTANT BECOMES DEFENSELESS.”.**
