1 AN ACT concerning

2 Public Institutions of Higher Education – Textbook Fairness Act

FOR the purpose of requiring the governing board of a public institution of higher
education to notify students of the textbooks assigned for certain courses on the
website of the institution at a certain time; requiring that the notification
contain certain information; prohibiting an employee of a public institution of
higher education from receiving certain benefits in exchange for requiring
students to purchase certain textbooks; and generally relating to textbooks
assigned for courses at public institutions of higher education.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

(A) (1) THE GOVERNING BOARD OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF
 HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL NOTIFY STUDENTS OF THE TEXTBOOKS ASSIGNED
 FOR EACH COURSE OFFERED AT THE INSTITUTION BY LISTING EACH ASSIGNED
 TEXTBOOK ON THE WEBSITE OF THE INSTITUTION WHEN THE COURSE
 INSTRUCTOR OR ACADEMIC DEPARTMENT OFFERING THE COURSE IDENTIFIES
 THE TEXTBOOK FOR ORDER AND SUBSEQUENT STUDENT PURCHASE.

1(2) THE NOTIFICATION SHALL INCLUDE THE INTERNATIONAL2STANDARD BOOK NUMBER (ISBN) FOR EACH TEXTBOOK.

3 (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
4 SUBSECTION, AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION
5 MAY NOT DEMAND OR RECEIVE ANY PAYMENT, LOAN, SUBSCRIPTION, ADVANCE,
6 SERVICE, OR ANY OTHER BENEFIT IN EXCHANGE FOR REQUIRING STUDENTS TO
7 PURCHASE A SPECIFIC TEXTBOOK FOR A COURSE.

8 (2) AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 9 EDUCATION MAY RECEIVE:

10(I)A COPY OF A TEXTBOOK THAT MAY NOT BE SOLD,11INCLUDING A SAMPLE COPY, INSTRUCTOR'S COPY, AND INSTRUCTIONAL12MATERIAL; AND

13(II) ROYALTIES OR OTHER COMPENSATION FROM THE SALE14OF A TEXTBOOK THAT INCLUDES THE WRITING OR RESEARCH OF THE15EMPLOYEE.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 July 1, 2008.
