### 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

15 5–304.

16 (b) Except as provided in subsections (a) and (d) of this section, an action for 17 unliquidated damages may not be brought against a local government or its employees 18 unless the notice of the claim required by this section is given within [180 days] **1** 19 **YEAR** after the injury.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.
