- 3 (B) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS
- 4 SECTION, AN APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE PROOF THAT IS SATISFACTORY TO
- 5 THE ADMINISTRATION THAT THE APPLICANT IS LICENSED OR CERTIFIED AS AN
- 6 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER UNDER § 13-516 OF THE
- 7 EDUCATION ARTICLE.
- 8 (C) The owner of a vehicle, or a lessee of a vehicle under a
- 9 LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, OR A DIRECTOR, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR

- 22 REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY, EACH TIME NEW
- 23 REGISTRATION PLATES ARE ISSUED FOR THE VEHICLE, A FEE SET BY THE
- 24 ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER THE ADMINISTRATION'S COSTS UNDER THIS
- 25 **SECTION.**
- 26 (2) THE ADDITIONAL FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION IS
- 27 NOT REQUIRED FOR SPECIAL REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE THAT IS EXEMPT
- 28 **UNDER § 13–903 OF THIS TITLE.**
- 29 (3) No portion of the fee collected under this section
- 30 MAY BE CREDITED TO THE GASOLINE AND MOTOR VEHICLE REVENUE
- 31 ACCOUNT FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 8-403 OR § 8-404 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 32 (E) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO GOVERN
- 33 THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
