1 AN ACT concerning

Heroes' Housing Fund of 2008

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Housing Program for First Responders and Teachers in the Department of Housing and Community Development; 4 specifying that the purpose of the Program is to authorize the Department to 5 purchase or contract to purchase and sell or contract to sell home loans made by 6 7 lending institutions to first responders and teachers; specifying that the loans 8 be made at the prices and on the terms and conditions that the Department 9 determines; specifying that the Program be operated with money in the Homeownership Programs Fund; authorizing the Department and lending 10 institutions to perform certain acts; requiring that home loans sales be insured 11 to a certain amount under certain circumstances; specifying the circumstances 12 13 under which an insured home loan is in default; authorizing the Department to enter into agreements with certain persons for certain purposes; requiring the 14 Department to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally 15 relating to home loans for first responders and teachers. 16
