3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Election Judges Training Pilot Program to be administered by the Center for American Politics and Citizenship at the 4 University of Maryland, College Park, and the Center for the Study of $\mathbf{5}$ Democracy at St. Mary's College of Maryland; requiring that the pilot program 6 be administered in conjunction with the State Board of Elections; specifying the 7 purpose of the pilot program; requiring the Governor to include certain funds in 8 9 the State budget to pay for the pilot program; requiring the Center for American 10 Politics and Citizenship and the Center for the Study of Democracy to submit a certain report on or before a certain date; defining a certain term; providing for 11 the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Election Judges 12 13 Training Pilot Program.
