BY adding to Article – Tax – Property Section 9–248 Annotated Code of Maryland (2007 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
