## Condominiums - Solar Panels - Restrictive Covenants

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a recorded covenant or restriction, a provision in a declaration, or a provision in the bylaws or rules of a condominium from 4 5 imposing or acting to impose unreasonable limitations on the installation of solar collection panels on the roof or exterior walls of the condominium building; 6 7 providing that, with respect to condominium buildings that are certain historic property, restrictive covenants may impose certain limitations on the 8 9 installation of solar collection panels on the building; and generally relating to the installation of solar collection panels on condominium buildings. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A RECORDED
- 21 COVENANT OR RESTRICTION, A PROVISION IN A DECLARATION, OR A PROVISION
- 22 IN THE BYLAWS OR RULES OF A CONDOMINIUM MAY NOT IMPOSE OR ACT TO
- 23 IMPOSE UNREASONABLE LIMITATIONS ON THE INSTALLATION OF SOLAR

1	COLLECTION PANELS ON THE ROOF OR EXTERIOR WALLS OF THE CONDOMINIUM
2	BUILDING.

- 3 (B) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A RESTRICTIVE COVENANT MAY IMPOSE LIMITATIONS ON THE INSTALLATION OF SOLAR COLLECTION PANELS ON CONDOMINIUM BUILDINGS THAT ARE HISTORIC PROPERTIES LISTED BY:
- 7 (1) THE MARYLAND INVENTORY OF HISTORIC PROPERTIES; OR
- 8 (2) THE MARYLAND REGISTER OF HISTORIC HOMES.
- 9 (C) THE LIMITATIONS IMPOSED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS 10 SECTION:
- 11 (1) MAY GOVERN THE SIZE, COLOR, AND LOCATION OF A SOLAR COLLECTION PANEL TO ENSURE AN UNOBTRUSIVE APPEARANCE; BUT
- 13 (2) MAY NOT PREVENT THE ECONOMICAL INSTALLATION OF A SOLAR COLLECTION PANEL.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
