- 3 FOR the purpose of enacting the Maryland Uniform Interstate Depositions and 4 Discovery Act; establishing procedures for requesting and issuing certain subpoenas; providing for the service of certain subpoenas; establishing that 5 6 certain Maryland Rules apply to certain subpoenas; requiring that an 7 application for a protective order or to enforce, quash, or modify certain 8 subpoenas comply with certain rules and statutes and be filed in a certain court; 9 requiring certain consideration to be given in applying and construing this Act; 10 defining certain terms; repealing existing provisions of law relating to foreign depositions; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to 11 interstate depositions and discovery. 12

4 (A) (1) TO REQUEST ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA UNDER THIS 5 SECTION, A PARTY SHALL SUBMIT A FOREIGN SUBPOENA TO A CLERK OF THE 6 CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH DISCOVERY IS SOUGHT TO BE 7 CONDUCTED IN THIS STATE.

8 (2) A REQUEST FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA UNDER THIS 9 SUBTITLE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN APPEARANCE IN THE COURTS OF THIS 10 STATE.
