## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## Baltimore City - Vehicle Laws - On-Street Parking

FOR the purpose of authorizing Baltimore City to enact an ordinance that allows a person to stop or park a vehicle in a certain manner on certain roadways; and generally relating to on-street parking in Baltimore City.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Article - Transportation
Section 21-1004(a)
Annotated Code of Maryland (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article - Transportation
Section 21-1004(b)
Annotated Code of Maryland (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

21-1004.
(a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a vehicle that is stopped or parked on a two-way roadway shall be stopped or parked parallel to the right hand curb or edge of the roadway, with its right hand wheels within 12 inches of that curb or edge of the roadway.

## (2) BALTIMORE CITY MAY ENACT AN ORDINANCE THAT:

(I) APPLIES TO ANY TWO-WAY ROADWAY DESIGNATED IN THE ORDINANCE; AND
(II) AUTHORIZES A PERSON TO STOP OR PARK A VEHICLE ON THE DESIGNATED ROADWAY PARALLEL TO THE CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY, WITH:

## 1. ITS RIGHT HAND WHEELS WITHIN 12 INCHES OF THE RIGHT HAND CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY; OR <br> 2. ITS LEFT HAND WHEELS WITHIN 12 INCHES OF THE LEFT HAND CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY.

(b) Except as otherwise provided by local ordinance, a vehicle that is stopped or parked on a one-way roadway shall be stopped or parked parallel to the curb or edge of the roadway, in the direction of authorized traffic movement, with:
(1) Its right hand wheels within 12 inches of the right hand curb or edge of the roadway; or
(2) Its left hand wheels within 12 inches of the left hand curb or edge of the roadway.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
