2 **Somerset County – Regulation of Dogs and Cats – Violations of Ordinances**
3 **and Regulations**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Somerset County to
5 impose civil and criminal penalties for violations of certain regulations relating
6 to dogs and cats; authorizing the County Commissioners of Somerset County to
7 provide that violations of certain dog and cat control ordinances may be
8 prosecuted in a certain manner; and generally relating to ordinances for the
9 regulation of dogs and cats.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 24 – Political Subdivisions – Miscellaneous Provisions**

19 (o) (1) In addition to and not in substitution for any powers granted under
20 this subtitle, the county commissioners of Dorchester, Garrett, and Somerset counties
21 may by ordinance provide for a comprehensive system for the regulation of dogs and

1 cats within the county, including licensing and control. These regulations may include
2 provision for the impounding and disposal of unlicensed or dangerous dogs and cats
3 and penalties, including [in Dorchester County and Garrett County] civil or criminal
4 penalties, for violations of any of the provisions of the regulations.

5 (2) In Dorchester County [and], Garrett County, **AND SOMERSET**
6 **COUNTY**, the County Commissioners may provide that a violation of a county dog or
7 cat control ordinance shall be prosecuted by the county in the same manner and to the
8 same extent as provided for municipal infractions under Article 23A, § 3(b) of the
9 Code.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2008.
