Medical Assistance Programs and Maryland Children's Health Program – Statements on State–Issued Checks

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to collaborate with the Office of the Comptroller or the Office of the State $\mathbf{5}$ 6 Treasurer to form a statement advising certain individuals that they may be 7 eligible to enroll in certain medical assistance programs or the Maryland 8 Children's Health Program and to print the statement on certain State-issued 9 checks; requiring that a certain statement require certain contact information; authorizing that a certain statement may be altered under certain 10 circumstances; and generally relating to medical assistance programs and 11 12 Maryland Children's Health Program statements on State-issued checks.
