- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 **8–403.1.**
- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "CHILD IN A HOME SCHOOL SETTING" MEANS A
- 18 CHILD WHO:
- 19 (1) DOES NOT ATTEND PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL; AND
- 20 (2) RECEIVES REGULAR THOROUGH INSTRUCTION DURING THE
- 21 SCHOOL YEAR IN THE STUDIES USUALLY TAUGHT IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO
- 22 CHILDREN OF THE SAME AGE.

- 1 (B) A CHILD WITH A DISABILITY IN A HOME SCHOOL SETTING SHALL BE
 2 GIVEN THE SAME CONSIDERATION AS A CHILD WITH A DISABILITY IN A PRIVATE
 3 SCHOOL SETTING FOR THE PURPOSE OF PASSING THROUGH FEDERAL FUNDS
 4 FOR THE PROVISION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES UNDER THE FEDERAL
 5 INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES ACT, 20 U.S.C. § 1412(A)(10).
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 2008.
