A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Public Utility Companies - Employees - Notice and Identification

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain employees of utility facility owners, including 4 contractors and subcontractors, to make certain efforts to determine if a 5 resident is home and make their presence known before entering private 6 residential property for certain purposes, with certain exceptions; requiring a 7 certain employee of a utility facility owner to post a certain notice of a certain visit; requiring certain employees of a utility facility owner to be clearly 8 9 identifiable as employees of the utility facility owner; requiring vehicles used by 10 certain employees of utility facility owners to be clearly identifiable and display a phone number, subject to a certain exception; providing for the construction of 11 this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to notice and 12 identification requirements for employees of a utility facility owner. 13

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23 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 24 MEANINGS INDICATED.



1 2 3	(2) (I) "UTILITY EMPLOYEE" OR "EMPLOYEE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A UTILITY FACILITY OWNER TO PERFORM MAINTENANCE OR INSPECTION OF A UTILITY FACILITY.
4 5 6	(II) "UTILITY EMPLOYEE" OR "EMPLOYEE" INCLUDES AN EMPLOYEE OF A CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR OF A UTILITY FACILITY OWNER.
7 8	(3) (I) "UTILITY FACILITY" MEANS PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT:
9 10	1. IS FOR USE IN CONNECTION WITH THE STORAGE OR CONVEYANCE OF WATER, SEWAGE, OIL, GAS, OR OTHER SUBSTANCES; OR
11 12 13 14	2. IS FOR USE IN TRANSMISSION OR CONVEYANCE OF ELECTRONIC, TELEPHONIC, OR TELEGRAPHIC COMMUNICATIONS OR ELECTRICITY, CABLE, ELECTRIC, GAS, SEWER, STEAM HEATING, TELEPHONE, OR WATER UTILITY SERVICE.
15 16 17	(II) "UTILITY FACILITY" INCLUDES PIPES, SEWERS, CONDUITS, CABLES, VALVES, LINES, WIRES, MANHOLES, ATTACHMENTS, METERS, AND POLES.
18 19	(III) "UTILITY FACILITY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A STORMWATER DRAIN.
20 21	(4) (I) "UTILITY FACILITY OWNER" MEANS A PERSON THAT OWNS OR OPERATES A UTILITY FACILITY.
22	(II) "UTILITY FACILITY OWNER" INCLUDES:
23	1. A CABLE TELEVISION CORPORATION;
24	2. AN ELECTRIC COMPANY;

3 4 5 6	(B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, BEFORE ENTERING PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY TO PERFORM MAINTENANCE OR INSPECTION OF A UTILITY FACILITY WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE TO THE PROPERTY OWNER, A UTILITY EMPLOYEE SHALL:
7 8	(I) KNOCK ON THE FRONT OR MAIN ENTRANCE OF THE RESIDENCE; OR
9 10 11	(II) MAKE OTHER REASONABLE EFFORTS TO DETERMINE WHETHER A RESIDENT IS AT HOME AND MAKE THE UTILITY EMPLOYEE'S PRESENCE KNOWN TO THE RESIDENT.
12 13 14	(2) This section does not require notification by or identification of a utility employee who visits a property solely to read the customer's utility meter.
15 16 17 18	(C) IF THE UTILITY EMPLOYEE FAILS TO CONTACT A RESIDENT, THE UTILITY EMPLOYEE SHALL POST NOTICE OF THE VISIT IN A CONSPICUOUS MANNER ON THE FRONT OR MAIN ENTRANCE OF THE RESIDENCE BEFORE LEAVING THE ENTRANCE.
19 20	(D) (1) A UTILITY EMPLOYEE SHALL BE CLEARLY IDENTIFIABLE ON SIGHT THROUGH IDENTIFICATION BADGES OR OTHER IDENTIFICATION.
21 22 23 24	(2) (I) EVERY VEHICLE USED BY A UTILITY EMPLOYEE SHALL BE CLEARLY IDENTIFIABLE ON SIGHT THROUGH DECALS OR OTHER MARKINGS AS A VEHICLE OF THE UTILITY FACILITY OWNER, ITS CONTRACTOR, OR SUBCONTRACTOR.
25 26 27 28 29 30	(II) THE TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE UTILITY FACILITY OWNER, ITS CONTRACTOR, OR SUBCONTRACTOR SHALL BE CLEARLY MARKED ON ALL OF THE VEHICLES OF THE UTILITY FACILITY OWNER, ITS CONTRACTOR, OR SUBCONTRACTOR, UNLESS THE UTILITY FACILITY OWNER MAINTAINS A PUBLICLY LISTED NUMBER THAT ANY MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC MAY USE TO CONTACT THE UTILITY FACILITY OWNER REGARDING THE PRESENCE OF A UTILITY EMPLOYEE OR A VEHICLE USED BY A UTILITY EMPLOYEE.
