3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Roads Board of Somerset County to sell 4 Charlie Swift Road in the Lawson Election District in Somerset County without 5 public sale and when the property is no longer needed for public use; providing 6 for a certain description of the property that is the subject of the sale authorized 7 by this Act; providing that the County Roads Board may arrange the terms, 8 conditions, and amount of consideration for and execute and acknowledge any 9 deeds or instruments necessary to complete any sale made in accordance with 10 this Act; and generally relating to the sale of Charlie Swift Road in Somerset 11 County.
