AN ACT concerning

## Vehicle Laws - Transporting Pets in Trucks or Trailers

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from transporting certain animals in or on a truck or trailer on a highway unless the truck or trailer is enclosed in a certain manner or unless the pet is confined in a certain manner; defining a certain term; establishing certain penalties for violations of this Act; and generally relating to the transportation of pets in or on trucks or trailers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation
21-1121.1.
(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "PET" MEANS A DOMESTICATED MAMMAL.
(2) "PET" DOES NOT INCLUDE LIVESTOCK AS DEFINED IN § 1-101 of THE Agriculture Article.
(B) A PERSON MAY NOT TRANSPORT A PET IN OR ON A TRUCK OR TRAILER ON A HIGHWAY UNLESS:
(1) THE TRUCK OR TRAILER IS ENCLOSED ON THE SIDES AND ON THE TOP IN A MANNER THAT SAFELY PREVENTS THE PET FROM FALLING, JUMPING, OR OTHERWISE EXITING THE TRUCK OR TRAILER; OR
(2) THE PET IS CONFINED BY A CONTAINER, CAGE, HARNESS, OR OTHER DEVICE DESIGNED TO SAFELY PREVENT THE PET FROM FALLING, JUMPING, OR OTHERWISE EXITING THE TRUCK OR TRAILER.
(C) FOR EACH PET TRANSPORTED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL FINE OF:
(1) \$100 FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE; AND
(2) \$250 FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
