BY adding to Article – Transportation Section 21–1121.1 Annotated Code of Maryland (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Transportation Section 27–101(b) Annotated Code of Maryland (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
