16 17	(a) In an action in which custody, visitation rights, or the amount of support of a minor child is contested, the court may:
18 19 20	(1) (i) appoint a lawyer who shall serve as a child advocate attorney to represent the minor child and who may not represent any party to the action; or
21 22	(ii) appoint a lawyer who shall serve as a best interest attorney to represent the minor child and who may not represent any party to the action; and



- 1 (2) impose **COUNSEL FEES** against [either or both parents counsel 2 fees] **ONE OR MORE PARTIES TO THE ACTION**.
