### 2 **Allegany County Planning Commission – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of members of the Allegany County  
4 Planning Commission to nine; and generally relating to the Allegany County  
5 Planning Commission.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article 66B – Land Use  
8 Section 14.01  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2003 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 13 **Article 66B – Land Use**

14 14.01.

- 15 (a) This section applies to Allegany County.
- 16 (b) The planning commission may consist of [seven] **NINE** members.
- 17 (c) (1) The term of each member is 5 years.
