Public Safety - Public Senior Higher Education Institutions - Housing Code Enforcement - Funding

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Housing and Community Development to provide matching grants and technical assistance to political 5 subdivisions to enforce certain local housing laws under certain circumstances; 6 7 authorizing the Department of Housing and Community Development to develop and use a certain formula to determine whether a political subdivision 8 9 is affected by the student population of a public senior higher education 10 institution; authorizing the Department of Housing and Community 11 Development to waive the requirement of a match if local money is not available; defining certain terms; and generally relating to certain funds to 12 enforce certain housing laws. 13

1 (2) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND 2 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.

3 (3) "PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION" HAS THE
4 MEANING STATED IN § 10–101(J) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

5 (B) (1) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROVIDE MATCHING GRANTS AND 6 TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS TO ENFORCE LOCAL 7 LAWS REGARDING THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHO MAY LIVE IN A HOUSING 8 UNIT.

9 (2) THE DEPARTMENT ONLY MAY PROVIDE MATCHING GRANTS 10 AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SECTION TO POLITICAL 11 SUBDIVISIONS THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES ARE AFFECTED BY THE 12 STUDENT POPULATION OF A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION.

13(3)THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A FORMULA THAT TAKES14INTO ACCOUNT CURRENT AND HISTORIC DEMOGRAPHICS, LOCAL HOUSING15ISSUES, ECONOMIC FACTORS, AND OTHER RELEVANT FACTORS TO:

16 (I) DETERMINE WHICH POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS ARE
17 AFFECTED BY THE STUDENT POPULATION OF A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER
18 EDUCATION INSTITUTION; AND

19(II) ALLOCATE THE MATCHING GRANTS AND TECHNICAL20ASSISTANCE AMONG ELIGIBLE POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

21(4) THE DEPARTMENT MAY WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT OF A22MATCH IF ADEQUATE LOCAL MONEY IS NOT AVAILABLE.
