FOR the purpose of requiring a certain number of members of the State Board of Education to be, at the time of their appointment, parents of students enrolled in public schools in the State; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the qualifications of members of the State Board of Education.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (2) The Governor shall appoint a new member to fill any vacancy on 2 the Board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and 3 qualifies.

4 (3) A member is eligible for reappointment but may not serve for more 5 than two full 4-year terms.

6 (4) The student member shall serve for a term of 1 year. A student 7 member is eligible for reappointment but may not serve more than two full 1-year 8 terms.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 10 construed to apply only prospectively to appointments to the State Board of Education 11 made after the effective date of this Act and may not be applied or interpreted to have 12 any effect on or application to the membership of the State Board of Education before 13 the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2008.
