12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 the Secretary may impose an administrative penalty on any person who violates any
 provision of this [subtitle] TITLE.

1 (b) The penalty imposed under this section may not exceed \$10,000.

2 (c) All penalties collected under this section shall be distributed to the 3 Animal Health Fund established under § 3–117 of this subtitle.
