12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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### Chapter 249 of the Acts of 2002

- 15 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of [5 years and 8 months] 17 **8 YEARS** and, at the end of [May 31, 2008] **SEPTEMBER 30, 2010** with no further 18 action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further
- 19 force and effect.
