10 11 12	(a) In this section, "emergency service transporter" means a public entity or volunteer fire, rescue, or emergency medical service that provides emergency medical services.
13 14 15 16	(b) If an emergency service transporter charges for its services and requests reimbursement from the Program, the Department shall reimburse the emergency service transporter, in an amount [not to exceed \$100 per transport] AS SPECIFIED BY REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT, for the cost of:
17 18	(1) Transportation the emergency service transporter provides to a Program recipient to a facility in response to a 911 call; and
19 20 21	(2) Medical services the emergency service transporter provides to the Program recipient while transporting the Program recipient to a facility in response to a 911 call.
