- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article 19 – Comptroller

15 37.

(a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each
county, municipal corporation, and taxing district in the State shall by the first day of
November after the close of the fiscal year file with the Department of Legislative
Services its financial report covering the full period of that fiscal year.

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1 (2) (i) Each county, municipal corporation, or taxing district with a 2 population of more than 400,000 may by the first day of January after the close of the 3 fiscal year file with the Department of Legislative Services its financial report 4 covering the full period of that fiscal year.

5 (ii) Unless subparagraph (i) of this paragraph applies, Howard 6 County may by the first day of December after the close of the fiscal year file with the 7 Department of Legislative Services its financial report covering the full period of that 8 fiscal year.

#### 9 (III) FREDERICK COUNTY MAY BY THE FIRST DAY OF 10 JANUARY AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT 11 OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES ITS FINANCIAL REPORT COVERING THE FULL 12 PERIOD OF THAT FISCAL YEAR.

13 (b) The reports required by subsection (a) of this section shall be:

14 (1) Properly filled in on the form or forms established by the 15 Department as provided in this subtitle; and

16 (2) Verified by the chief executive officer of each county, municipal17 corporation, and taxing district.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 19 October 1, 2008.
