1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Police Training Commission - Membership and Chairman**

3 FOR the purpose of replacing the Deputy Secretary of the Department of Public Safety
4 and Correctional Services with the Secretary of the Department as a member of
5 the Police Training Commission; designating the Secretary of State Police as
6 chair of the Police Training Commission; and generally related to the Police
7 Training Commission.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article - Public Safety
10 Section 3-203(a) and 3-204
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2003 Volume and 2007 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Public Safety**

16 3-203.

17 (a) (1) The Commission consists of 15 members.

18 (2) Of the 15 members of the Commission:

- 1 (i) one shall be the President of the Maryland Chiefs of Police
2 Association;
- 3 (ii) one shall be the President of the Maryland Sheriffs
4 Association;
- 5 (iii) one shall be the President of the Maryland Law
6 Enforcement Officers, Inc.;
- 7 (iv) one shall be the Attorney General of the State;
- 8 (v) one shall be the Secretary of State Police;
- 9 (vi) one shall be the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City;
- 10 (vii) one shall be the Chancellor of the University System of
11 Maryland;
- 12 (viii) one shall be the agent in charge of the Baltimore office of the
13 F.B.I.;
- 14 (ix) one shall be the President of the Eastern Shore Police
15 Association;
- 16 (x) one shall represent the Maryland State Lodge of Fraternal
17 Order of Police;
- 18 (xi) one shall be the [Deputy] Secretary of Public Safety and
19 Correctional Services;
- 20 (xii) one shall be the Chairman of the Maryland Municipal
21 League Police Executive Association; and
- 22 (xiii) three shall be police officials of the State appointed under
23 subsection (b) of this section.

25 (a) The [Deputy] Secretary of [Public Safety and Correctional Services or the
26 Deputy Secretary's representative] **STATE POLICE** is the chairman of the
27 Commission.

28 (b) The Commission annually shall elect a vice chairman from among its
29 members.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
31 October 1, 2008.
