12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Criminal Procedure

16 (a) Except as provided under [subsection] SUBSECTIONS (b) AND (C) of this 17 section, the record of a proceeding before the Board or a Board member is a public 18 record.

(b) If the confidentiality of a record or report that the Board obtains is
protected by law or regulation, the record or report shall remain confidential, subject
to the law or regulation.

1 (C) THE BOARD MAY NOT ALLOW THE INSPECTION, USE, OR 2 DISCLOSURE OF A VICTIM'S OR CLAIMANT'S NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE 3 NUMBER, OR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER PROVIDED TO THE BOARD.
