## A BILL ENTITLED

## AN ACT concerning

## Criminal Injuries Compensation Board - Criminal Offense Outside of the United States

FOR the purpose of altering a certain definition to include criminal offenses committed outside of the United States for the purpose of claims to the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board; and generally relating to the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board and criminal offenses outside of the United States.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Article - Criminal Procedure
Section 11-801(d)
Annotated Code of Maryland (2001 Volume and 2007 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Criminal Procedure
11-801.
(d) (1) "Crime" means:
(i) except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a criminal offense under state, federal, or common law that is committed in:

1. this State;[or]
2. another state against a resident of this State; or

## 3. ANOTHER COUNTRY OR TERRITORY OUTSIDE OF

 THE UNITED STATES AGAINST A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE; OR(ii) an act of international terrorism as defined in Title 18, § 2331 of the United States Code that is committed outside of the United States against a resident of this State.
(2) "Crime" does not include an act involving the operation of a vessel or motor vehicle unless the act is:
(i) a violation of § $20-102, \S 20-104, \S 21-902$, or § $21-904$ of the Transportation Article; or
(ii) operating a motor vehicle or vessel that results in an intentional injury.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
