24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 4 $\mathbf{5}$ applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 1996 but before January 6 1, [2011] 2014; provided, however, that the tax credit under § 21-309 of the 7 Education Article, as enacted under Section 1 of this Act, shall be allowed only for 8 employees hired on or after October 1, 1997 but before July 1, [2008] 2011; and provided further that any excess credits under § 21–309 of the Education Article may 9 be carried forward and, subject to the limitations under § 21-309 of the Education 10 Article, may be applied as a credit for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 11 12[2011] **2014**.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
of Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997. It shall remain in
effect for a period of [10] 13 years and 9 months and at the end of June 30, [2008]
2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 21applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 1996 but before January 22231, [2011] 2014; provided, however, that the tax credit under § 21-309 of the 24Education Article, as enacted under Section 1 of this Act, shall be allowed only for 25employees hired on or after October 1, 1997 but before July 1, [2008] 2011; and 26provided further that any excess credits under § 21–309 of the Education Article may be carried forward and, subject to the limitations under § 21-309 of the Education 2728Article, may be applied as a credit for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 29 [2011] **2014**.

30 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions 31 of Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997. It shall remain in 32 effect for a period of [10] **13** years and 9 months and at the end of June 30, [2008] 33 **2011**, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be 34 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
