1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Howard County – Local Government Tort Claims Act – Revenue Authority**

3 **Ho. Co. 04-08**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of “local government” under the Local
5 Government Tort Claims Act to include the Howard County Revenue Authority;
6 making conforming changes; providing for the application of this Act; and
7 generally relating to the inclusion of the Howard County Revenue Authority
8 under the Local Government Tort Claims Act.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings
11 Section 5–301(d) and 5–304(a)
12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

17 5–301.

18 (d) “Local government” means:

19 (1) A chartered county established under Article 25A of the Code;

2 [(20)] **(21)** A commercial district management authority established by
3 a county or municipal corporation if provided under local law;

4 [(21)] **(22)** The Baltimore City Police Department;

5 [(22)] **(23)** A regional library resource center or a cooperative library
6 corporation established under Title 23, Subtitle 2 of the Education Article;

7 [(23)] **(24)** Lexington Market, Inc., in Baltimore City;

8 [(24)] **(25)** The Baltimore Public Markets Corporation, in Baltimore
9 City;

10 [(25)] **(26)** The nonprofit corporation serving as the local public
11 transportation authority for Carroll County pursuant to a contract or memorandum of
12 understanding with Carroll County (Carroll County Senior Overland Service, Inc., t/a
13 Carroll Area Transit System);

14 [(26)] **(27)** The nonprofit corporation serving as the animal control and
15 licensing authority for Carroll County pursuant to a contract or memorandum of
16 understanding with Carroll County (the Humane Society of Carroll County, Inc.);

17 [(27)] **(28)** Garrett County Municipalities, Inc., in Garrett County; and

18 [(28)] **(29)** The nonprofit corporation serving as the local public
19 transportation authority for Garrett County pursuant to a contract or memorandum of
20 understanding with Garrett County (Garrett County Community Action Committee,
21 Inc.).

23 (a) This section does not apply to an action against a nonprofit corporation
24 described in [§ 5-301(d)(23), (24), (25), (26), or (28)] **§ 5-301(D)(24), (25), (26), (27),**
25 **OR (29)** of this subtitle or its employees.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
27 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
28 any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of
29 this Act.

30 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
31 October 1, 2008.
