1 AN ACT concerning

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Department of Housing and Community Development – Disaster Relief Housing Program

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Disaster Relief Housing Program within the Department of Housing and Community Development for the purpose of 5 6 providing financial assistance to certain families and nonprofit entities in certain disaster areas for certain purposes; authorizing the Department to fund 7 8 the Program; specifying the sources and types of funding and financial assistance the Department may provide under the Program; requiring the 9 Secretary of Housing and Community Development to adopt certain 10 regulations, guidelines, eligibility requirements, and income limits for the 11 Program; requiring that repayments under the Program be paid to the source of 12 funds used to provide the financial assistance; requiring the Department to 13 issue certain reports to the General Assembly on or before certain dates; and 14 generally relating to the Disaster Relief Housing Program in the Department of 15 Housing and Community Development. 16
