Family Law - Child Custody and Visitation - Military Deployment

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that, in a child custody or visitation proceeding 4 involving a parent who is on certain active military duty, any order or modification of an existing child custody or visitation order issued by the court 5 6 during a certain period of time be a temporary order and specifically reference 7 certain information; establishing that, at the end of the active military duty of 8 the parent, a certain order terminates or reverts to a certain previous order 9 under certain circumstances; authorizing either parent to petition the court to issue a new child custody or visitation order under certain circumstances; and 10 generally relating to military deployment and child custody or visitation orders. 11

- 11 (B) AT THE END OF THE DEPLOYMENT OR FEDERAL ACTIVE DUTY OF 12 THE PARENT, AN ORDER ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 13 SHALL:
- 14 **(1) TERMINATE**; **OR**
- 15 (2) IN THE CASE OF A MODIFICATION OF AN EXISTING ORDER, 16 REVERT TO THE PREVIOUS ORDER.
- 17 (C) AT THE END OF THE DEPLOYMENT OR FEDERAL ACTIVE DUTY OF 18 THE PARENT, EITHER PARENT MAY PETITION THE COURT TO ISSUE A NEW 19 CHILD CUSTODY OR VISITATION ORDER.
