- 2 (II) "DELIVER" DOES NOT INCLUDE DELIVERY BY MEANS OF 3 THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OR A PRIVATE MAIL DELIVERY SERVICE.
- 4 (3) "PRINT PUBLICATION" MEANS A CIRCULAR, NEWSPAPER,
- 5 MAGAZINE, PAPER, OR BOOKLET THAT IS PUBLISHED AT REGULAR INTERVALS
- 6 AND DISTRIBUTED TO THE PUBLIC.

- 4 (D) (1) A VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS:
- 5 (I) AN UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE WITHIN 6 THE MEANING OF TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- 7 (II) SUBJECT TO THE ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS
- 8 CONTAINED IN TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 9 (2) A PUBLISHER WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A 10 CIVIL FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
