- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Environment
- 14 15–407.

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- 15 (a) In this section, "pozzolan" means the finely divided residue which results 16 from combustion of ground or powdered coal and is released by combustion gases, as 17 defined by the test methods published by the American Society for Testing Methods.
- 18 (b) (1) [Any person who uses pozzolan for landfill shall do so in a manner which complies with sound engineering practices.
- 20 (2) Any] A person [who uses] MAY NOT USE pozzolan for landfill, 21 [structural building,] soil improvement, agriculture, soil conditioning, or land 22 reclamation [shall minimize dust and wind erosion and shall comply with all silt 23 control regulations and permit requirements of the Department].



- 1 (2) POZZOLAN SHALL BE DISPOSED OF IN A REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEM REGULATED UNDER §§ 9–204, 9–252, AND 9–314 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2008.
