1 (c) (1) A Class A light wine license may be issued by the license issuing 2 authority of the county in which the place of business is located to any holder of a 3 Class 4 manufacturer's license.

4 (2) A winery in Cecil County that applies for a Class A/Class 4 license 5 is exempt from any quotas established by the Cecil County Board of License 6 Commissioners as to the number of licenses in the election district where the winery is 7 located.

8 (3) A winery in Baltimore County that applies for a Class A/Class 4 9 license is exempt from any quotas established by the Baltimore County Board of 10 License Commissioners as to the number of licenses in the election district where the 11 winery is located.

12 (4) A WINERY IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY THAT IS ISSUED A CLASS 13 A/CLASS 4 LICENSE MAY OPERATE NOT MORE THAN FIVE OFF-SITE RETAIL 14 LOCATIONS:

- 15 (I) FOR WINE SAMPLING; AND
- 16(II)TO SELL WINE FOR CONSUMPTION ON AND OFF THE17PREMISES.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 June 1, 2008.
