AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 2, 6, and 7 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, 2008, with no further action required by the General Assembly, these sections shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]
