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1 [SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any fees repealed under 2 this Act shall remain in full force and effect until the fees authorized to be set in 3 accordance with Section 2 of this Act are adopted and made effective.]

4 ESECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 2, 6, and 7 2
5 AND 6 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 5 10 years and 1 month and, at
6 the end of June 30, 2008 2013, with no further action required by the General
7 Assembly, these sections shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 July 1, 2008.
