BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – State Personnel and Pensions Section 24–401.1(k), 26–401.1(k), and 29–111 Annotated Code of Maryland (2004 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - State Personnel and Pensions 24-401.1.
