### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Advisory Committee to Coordinate the Public Health System and Drug Treatment Funded by the Medical Assistance Program

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Advisory Committee to Coordinate the Public 5 Health System and Drug Treatment Funded by the Medical Assistance 6 Program; providing for the membership of the Advisory Committee; requiring 7 the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to appoint the chair of the Advisory 8 Committee; providing for certain quorum requirements; requiring the Advisory 9 Committee to meet a certain number of times each year; authorizing members 10 of the Advisory Committee to receive certain reimbursement; providing for the 11 staffing of the Advisory Committee; requiring the Advisory Committee to make certain recommendations and to make a certain annual report to the Governor 12 and certain committees of the General Assembly; providing for the termination 13 14 of this Act; and generally relating to the Advisory Committee to Coordinate the 15Public Health System and Drug Treatment Funded by the Medical Assistance 16 Program.

2 (A) THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT THE CHAIR OF THE ADVISORY 3 COMMITTEE.

4 (B) THE MEMBERS PRESENT AT A MEETING ARE A QUORUM TO DO 5 BUSINESS.

6 (C) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL MEET AT LEAST FOUR TIMES A 7 YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.

8 (D) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE MAY NOT RECEIVE 9 COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE, BUT IS 10 ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE 11 TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

12 (E) THE ALCOHOL AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION AND THE MEDICAL 13 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL JOINTLY PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT AND 14 TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

16 THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO 17 ENHANCE COORDINATION BETWEEN THE PUBLIC HEALTH SYSTEM AND THE 18 DRUG TREATMENT SYSTEM FUNDED BY THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, 19 INCLUDING METHODS TO:

20 (1) FACILITATE ENROLLMENT IN THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE 21 PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS IN NEED OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG TREATMENT;

(2) USE DATA FROM BOTH THE PUBLIC HEALTH SYSTEM AND THE
 MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT AND
 OVERSIGHT; AND

- 25 (3) REDUCE BARRIERS TO CARE IN THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
  26 PROGRAM, INCLUDING ISSUES RELATED TO:
- 27 (I) **REIMBURSEMENT RATES;**
- 28 (II) **DENIAL OF CLAIMS; AND**
- 29 (III) **PRIOR APPROVAL.**

1 ON OR BEFORE JUNE 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE 2 SHALL REPORT ITS RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN 3 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE 4 SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE HEALTH AND GOVERNMENT 5 OPERATIONS COMMITTEE.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 2008. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 8 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be 9 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
