## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## State Real Estate Commission - Investigative Staff - Employment and Payment

FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that certain investigative staff of the State Real Estate Commission be employed in accordance with the State budget; requiring the Commission to pay certain investigative staff from the State Real Estate Commission Fund, subject to certain conditions; providing that certain investigative staff may not be subject to certain hiring moratoriums or certain PIN eliminations; and generally relating to the employment and payment of investigative staff of the State Real Estate Commission.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Business Occupations and Professions

17-206.
(b) (1) The Commission[, in accordance with the State budget,] may employ an investigative staff to conduct investigations.
(2) SUbJECT To the availability of funds in the State Real Estate Commission Fund established under § 2-106.3 of the

BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE, THE COMMISSION SHALL PAY INVESTIGATIVE STAFF FROM THE STATE REAL ESTATE COMMISSION FUND.
(3) INVESTIGATIVE STAFF EMPLOYED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND PAID UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE SUBJECT TO HIRING MORATORIUMS OR PIN ELIMINATIONS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
