18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Personnel and Pensions

21 8–103.

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[(a)] Subject to the approval of the Governor, the Secretary shall adopt regulations to carry out this subtitle.



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- [(b) Subject to § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the Secretary shall submit to the Department of Legislative Services, on or before September 1 of each year, a list of the position, pay grade and step, and pay rate of each employee who was included in the Executive Pay Plan as of the preceding June 30.]
