A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Procurement – Unsolicited Proposals – Repeal of Termination Date**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination date for the use of unsolicited proposals
4 as a method of State procurement; and generally relating to unsolicited
5 proposals.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 Chapter 482 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002
8 Section 4

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
10 MARYLAND, That the laws of Maryland read as follows:

11 **Chapter 482 of the Acts of 2002**

12 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2002. [It shall remain effective for a period of 6 years and, at the end of
14 September 30, 2008, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
15 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2008.
