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Motor Vehicle Accident Reports - Access

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the period of time during which certain persons may 4 access a certain motor vehicle accident report; authorizing owners of certain 5 motor vehicles and property to access a certain motor vehicle accident report 6 during a certain time following the date the motor vehicle accident occurred; 7 requiring a person that accesses a certain motor vehicle accident report during a 8 certain time after the motor vehicle accident occurred to present certain 9 information to certain authorized employees; providing for certain exceptions; 10 providing that certain persons who knowingly disclose a certain motor vehicle accident report to certain persons are subject to a certain penalty; and generally 11 relating to motor vehicle accident reports. 12
