1 AN ACT concerning

Licensed Counselors and Therapists – Appraisal Activities – Training Requirements

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "appraisal" relating to the use of certain 4 5 instruments by certain licensed counselors and therapists repealing a certain 6 requirement that the Board of Examiners of Psychologists and the State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists jointly approve certain training for 7 licensed counselors and therapists; authorizing certain licensed counselors and 8 9 therapists to engage in certain appraisal activities that include the use of certain instruments if certain training has been completed; and generally 10 relating to appraisal activities and licensed counselors and therapists. 11
