Criminal Procedure - Sexual Offenders - Supervision, Notifications, and Penalties

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the inclusion of certain additional information in a registration statement for the offender registry; requiring a supervising 5 6 authority to verify the address of certain registrants; expanding the types of 7 child care entities that may be notified by a local law enforcement unit of the 8 filing of a registration statement under certain circumstances; prohibiting a 9 person from knowingly assisting a person, who is subject to certain registration 10 requirements and fails to comply with those requirements, in eluding a law enforcement agency or certain supervising authority by withholding information 11 regarding the whereabouts of the person under certain circumstances or by 12 providing false information; establishing a certain penalty; and generally 13 14 relating to sexual offenders.
